LETTER OF REFERENCE FOR COOPER ROTHE

I have known Cooper as a baseball player since the age of 10 and as a student-athlete at Longmont High School since his Freshman year. He is not only a quality baseball player, but also a quality student and person.

Cooper's ability earned him a starting outfield position for the 2013 spring baseball season, his Freshman year. He was clearly one of our best defensive outfielders from the outset and saw significant playing time that year. He became the full time Varsity centerfielder at the start of the summer 2013 AABC U18 season and rapidly become a very good Varsity player. Cooper is a solid hitter who hits in the lead-off spot for us, gets on base, steals bases, and scores runs. He is currently hitting .348 with 4 doubles, .464 OB%, 14 SB, and only 3 SO in 56 at bats. This last summer playing AABC 18U he hit .347 in 124 at bats with 5 doubles, 2 triples, 1 HR, 30 stolen bases, and only 11 SO. Defensively, Cooper runs well and, along with excellent jumps, covers a lot of ground and has good glove skills. He also has 12 assists over the last 70 games, a testament to his work at improving arm strength and accuracy. He is dedicated to becoming the best he can and continues to improve all aspects of his game.

Cooper is also the starting CB on the state runner up football team and a guard on the state runner up basketball team. He was first in the state in interceptions and earned All-Conference, All Area, and All State honors.

Cooper is a well-rounded athlete who has a great desire to play baseball at the collegiate level. I know Cooper has the leadership, skills, and work ethic to succeed at that next level.
